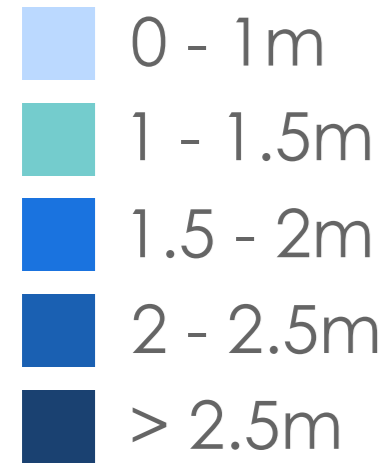


Weston-super-Mare Marine Lake

Water depth

Water depth*



* Depths are relative to the Impounded Water Level (IWL) of Marine Lake, which is equal to the crest height of the seawall (on the marine lake side).

Important Information

- Water depth in the Marine Lake varies; around most of the edge it is less than 1m deep
- It is dangerous to jump or dive from the edge
- The Lake is deepest (over 2m) near the seawall
- The water level and the depths shown vary depending on the state of the tide and so actual water depths may be shallower than shown
- Survey date: May 2022, natural siltation of the lake will reduce depths over time
- The base of the lake is concrete, clay or shingle, with naturally occurring silt, sands, stones and rocks on top
- The base of Marine Lake around the northern perimeter is concrete
- Protect your feet with appropriate footwear
- Please be aware of other users, and make sure they can see you
- Stay out of the water when the sea overtops or covers the seawall
